


RABBIT AND GUINEA PIG FEEDING GUIDE

^{**}Chinese Vegetables, Celery, Broccoli Leaves, Spinach, Silverbeet, Carrot Tops, Rocket, Kale, Chicory, Endive. – for a 2kg rabbit or 2 guinea pigs they can have a loosely packed 3L container of greens per day.
